EU Settlement Scheme: What Happens Next?

Home Office Status Outcome

- Keep your status outcome letter in a safe place.
- We recommend that you print and file this letter in an email directory so that it can be easily retrieved at a later date.
- Please note that status outcome letter is not proof of your status. Your proof of status will be accessed by logging into your online portal.

Logging Into The Portal

You can prove your status via the Home Office online status service 'View and Prove your Settled and Pre-Settled Status': <https://www.gov.uk/view-prove-immigration-status>. Below is the information you will need to have to log into your portal:

ID Document Number (Passport/ID Card)

D.O.B

Mobile number/Email

- A code will be sent to you to access your portal

You will need to tell the Home Office if you change your contact email, phone number or ID document. To do this, log into your status portal. Alternatively, call the EU Resolution Centre on 0300 123 7379.

Conditions with Settled Status

Once your Settled status is granted, you can spend up to 5 years in a row outside of the UK without losing your status.

However, if you're absent from the UK for over 5 years, you will lose your Settled status.

*Serious criminal offences that are committed after your Settled status is granted could lead to revocation of your status.

Proving your Status via The Portal

If you need to prove your status with employers, landlords or other organisations/agencies you may use the Home Office online status service 'View and Prove your Settled and Pre-Settled Status'. <https://www.gov.uk/view-prove-immigration-status>

- A share code can be generated upon this site which you can then use to prove your status.

British Citizenship

You may be eligible to apply for British Citizenship **12 months after** the date of your Settled status was granted.

Date Settled Status was granted:

*New criminal convictions may affect your eligibility in applying for British Citizenship.
